

1. Introduction: -

In June 1971, Ajintha Education Society, Aurangabad established a Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru College. The College started its functioning in the premises of Narali Baug Area. The Library started its working in a single room with four cupboards and 500 books (including Reference Books, Dictionaries, etc.). The library started its work with the collection of some 1,756 books by the end of the year 1971 - 72. The collection in the library is increasing year after year and at present the collection has crossed the number 20,000 mark. In 2000 - 01 the college shifted to a rented MIT building near Cidco Bustand Road. The library started in a hall in the building, with the collection of 14,082 books. Since 1984 – 85 the library received first grants from University Grants Commission to purchase the books. The collection reached up to 7,397 books in the year 1984-85. The library again shifted in its rented Foster Development B.Ed college building in the year 2003-04. And lastly in the year 2007 – 08 the library was shifted to its own building at Shivaji Nagar in hall. After a due permission of the Hon'ble. Chairman of the Ajintha Education Society, Shri. Ranganathji Kal, the library is shifted to a big hall on the ground floor; Due to its new location at the ground floor right at the entrance facilitated more students for greater access of library usage.

Earlier Shri. M. K. Patil worked as a Librarian of this college from 1971 – 2012. On the 31st May 2010 Shri M.K. Patil Librarian retired and in the year 2012 Shri. R.R. Tupe has joined as a librarian on 01 – June – 2012 and is working till today.

5. Arrangement of books in the library
